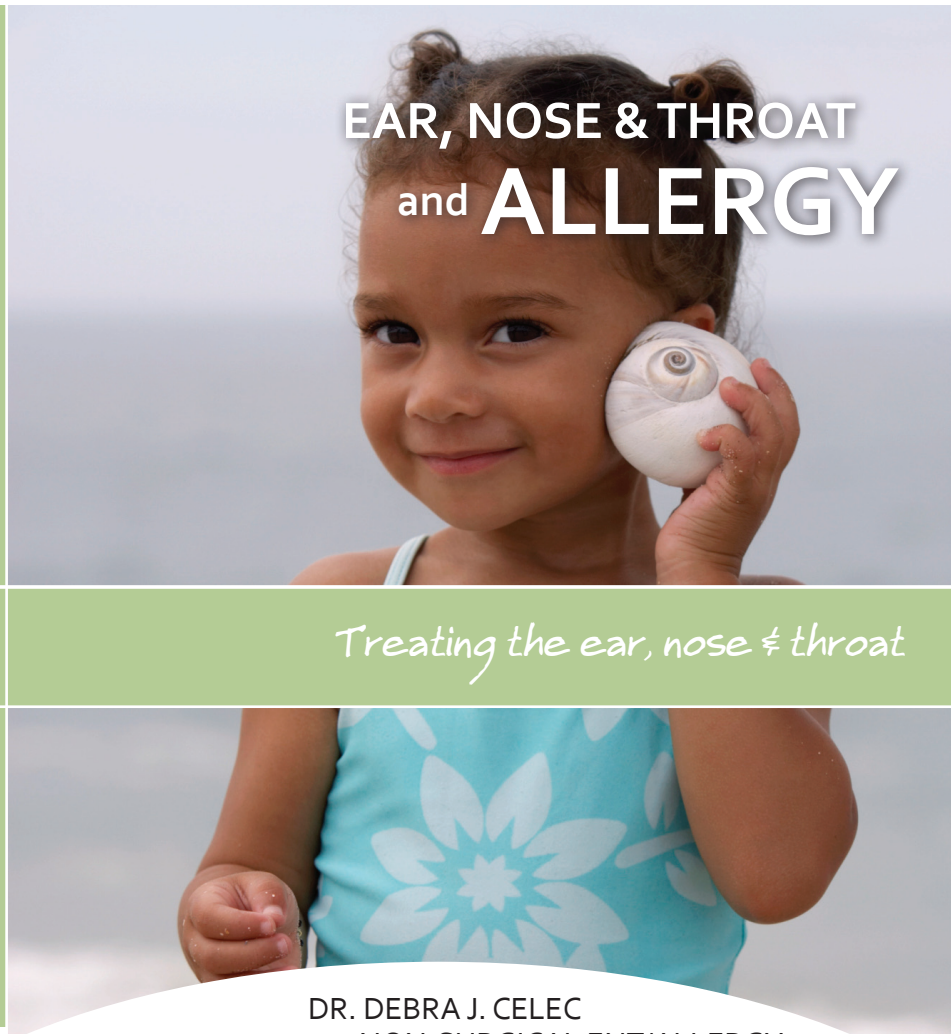
Dr. Celec is located in the physician's office within Galion Community Hospital as well as near Bucyrus Community Hospital on Hill St. in Bucyrus.



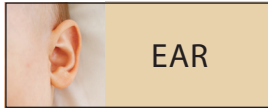
Symptoms of allergy sufferers include:

- Disturbed sleep

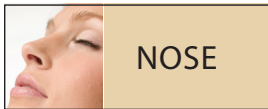

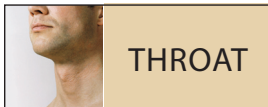
## EVALUATE and TREATMENT
